Camper Responsibilities

1. The 9th Lithuanian Scouts Association National Jamboree Camp will take place at the BSA Manatoc Scout Reservation, 1065 Truxell Road, Peninsula, OH., 44264 (30 miles south of Cleveland, OH). The camp emergency phone number is 603-817-4452.
2. Campers may begin arriving at the camp after 12 noon on August 9, 2008. Primary leaders may arrive Friday, August 8, 2008. The first meal to be served will begin with dinner, on August 9, 2008.
3. Guests may visit the camp during the middle weekend of August 16 – 17, 2008. There are no sleeping facilities at the camp for guests. All guests will be required to register at the Registration pavilion.
4. All campers must be pre-registered for the camp, regardless of the number of nights they will be camping. Campers registered for four or less days and campers in the „Jaunų Šeimos“ campsites must supply their own tent.
5. The camp closing ceremony will be on Monday evening, August 18, 2008. Campers will not be leaving the Camp before 12 noon on August 19, 2008.
6. Camp participants must be:
 - a) Paid registered members of the Lithuanian Scouts Association.
 - b) Pre-registered prior to the opening of the camp.
7. The Camp store will be open during designated free time. Campers will be able to purchase various items at the store, in addition to souvenirs of the National Jamboree Camp.
8. All vehicles of registered campers will be parked for the duration of the camp, in designated parking lots. These vehicles must be registered with the Camp Administration at the time of check-in to the camp. Only authorized vehicles may be used on Camp property during the duration of the camp, as designated by the Camp Director. Visitor cars will only be allowed to park in designated parking lots.
9. Campers baggage will be delivered from the Camp's check-in site to as near as possible, the camper's troop site.
10. Swimming facilities will be available for the campers during the camp at predesignated times. Water safety staff will be present during all swimming activities. All campers must adhere to the rules and requirements of the BSA water safety instructors.
11. A First Aid lodge will be manned 24 hours per day during the duration of the camp. The BSA staff will have all the necessary arrangements made with local emergency agencies and hospital facility.
12. **Vilkiukai/Paukštytės/ Urdytės/Bebrai:** Due to the special nature of this National Jamboree Camp, the large number of campers participating and the longer distances participants are traveling, this camp is not intended to accommodate all of our youngest members. Based on past tradition and practice, separate camps in the different regions of the Lithuanian Scouts Association are organized for these campers. However, this National Jamboree Camp will have a small area and program set up for young campers from the Cleveland area and children of leaders working at the camp. All of these participants must be at least 8 years of age as of August 9, 2008. Campers younger than 8 years of age must camp in the family area with at least one parent or guardian.
13. **Skautai Vyčiai/Vyresnės Skautės/Jūrių Budžiai/Gintarės:** The program for this area of the National Jubilee Camp can only accommodate candidates for these scouting levels or Skautai Vyčiai, Vyresnės Skautės, Jūrių Budžiai or Gintarės up to 23 years of age. Members older than 23 years of age, must take leadership positions in the camp or must camp in the adult camp areas (Bendrija, Akademikai).

14. During the duration of the camp:
- a) The use of alcohol and illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
 - b) Firearms, ammunition, fireworks, slingshots, projectiles and sheath knives shall not be brought to Camp.
 - c) All forms of harassment is strictly prohibited.
 - d) All forms of hazing are strictly prohibited.
 - e) Campers may only visit other camp sites during designated hours. Campers may not leave their campsite after „Tyla“.
 - f) The cutting of any standing tree or removal of bark is strictly prohibited.
 - g) No registered camper should leave the Camp for any reason without the prior approval of the Camp Director.
 - h) Smoking is prohibited by all Scouts less than 18 years of age. Adults are not to smoke in front of Scouts or minors or in buildings on camp property.
 - i) The use of electronic devices is prohibited; i.e. IPOD's, radios etc.
 - j) Cell phones may only be used during designated free time.
15. All campers and guests are required to abide and respect the rules of the camp.
16. We are guests of the BSA Manatoc Scout reservation. All the rules and regulations of the Scout reservation are applicable to all registered members of the Lithuanian Scouts Association. The camp sites must be left, as we found them, upon completion of the National Jamboree Camp.
17. The above camper responsibilities are illustrative only, and do not constitute any limitation upon the authority of the IX Lithuanian National Jamboree Camp Director to take action as is deemed appropriate for the furtherance of personal safety and preservation of Camp property, or to promulgate additional rules, regulations, policies or procedures governing this National Jamboree Camp.
18. Failure to abide by these responsibilities and rules of the National Jamboree Camp may result in expulsion from the camp. If a camper is dismissed from the camp, there will be no refund of camp fees.
